Equipment Needs

Fetal Monitoring Link \$286,548

The Fetal Monitoring equipment and technology would enable a labor and delivery nurse to continually monitor an obstetrical patient. If a nurse is called outside a patient’s room, their condition can be constantly monitored either by the nurse or from a central location. The technology will provide a comprehensive record of care by incorporating the fetal monitoring data and vital signs into the lifetime medical record. This equipment would provide an increased safety measure for our mothers and babies.

EKG Muse System \$395,264

The Muse system would be interfaced with our new electronic medical record which would allow results of the EKG to be stored for future references and quick accessibility. EKG’s could also be performed at a satellite clinic or other area facility and sent electronically to NMRH for interpretation by a board certified cardiologist. Patient care decisions can be made within minutes or hours instead of days or weeks.

Patient Monitors \$432,030

A total of 40 monitors will be purchased. The patient monitors allow the nurses to accurately monitor blood pressure, ECG, pulse, oxygen saturation, respirations and temperature. The monitors will be utilized in Ambulatory Surgery, Recovery Room and the Endoscopy Unit and will be interfaced with our electronic medical record which can be accessed immediately by all medical personnel.
